The International Congress (iCongress) is the annual Youth and Christian Education Conference of the historic Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ of the Apostolic Faith, Inc. (COOLJC). Its mission is designed to provide a collaborative structure for the coordination and administration of the International Sunday School Association (Christian Education) and International Armor Bearers Young Peoples' Union (Youth) programs and activities.

The iCongress provides training for current and potential leaders to work effectively on the local, state, national and international levels of COOLJC and beyond. The iCongress also seeks to develop the total person which enhances Christian fellowship and commitment to Christ. The Conference caters to and attracts a diverse demographic of attendees from children to Pastors and senior leaders. The Conference spans across four days and is inclusive of 7 workshop tracks, a leadership luncheon, multiple worship services, evening social activities, 2 annual competitions (Bible Bowl and Oratorical) and much more. The conference is the second largest attended meeting of COOLJC out of its four international meetings.
